

# Autumn Wowza Scarf Pattern from the [www.knit1fortheroad.com](http://www.knit1fortheroad.com) website

All knits are flat knit or real knit stitches  
(not e-wraps) I used the flat knit stitch.  
Single Strand of WW is used throughout this  
pattern.



## Tools Used:

Knifty Knitter Purple Round Adult Loom  
About 4 ounces of Worsted Weight Yarn

Cast on 18 stitches

## Ribbing

K2, P2 for two inches

## Set up rows

Row 1 & 2 K1, P1, Knit across row to last 2 sts, K1, P1.

Next Row starts the four rows of your pattern

## Pattern Rows

Row 1 & 2: K1, P1, Knit across row to last 2 sts, K1, P1.

Row 3: K1, P1 - K4, P3, K4, P3, K4 - K1, P1.

Row 4: K1, P1, Knit across row to last 2 sts, K1, P1.

Repeat these 4 pattern rows for desired length.

Continue with the set up instructions.

Row 1 & 2 K1, P1, Knit across row to last 2 sts, K1, P1.

Repeat Ribbing for 2”

Bind off in pattern.

This pattern did curl a bit; however, I used the steam burst on my iron to flatten it out and that seemed to work for me. Be careful if you use an iron – always use a press cloth. This is acrylic yarn and will melt if heated too much.

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
